

INFORMATION ON OUR PROGRAM

The Children's Dyslexia Centers of New Jersey is a private charity run by the Scottish Rite Masons in conjunction with FDU's Center for Dyslexia Studies.

Children attend the Hasbrouck Heights, NJ Center on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:30 to 5:30 or 5:30 to 6:30.

Children attend the Tenaflly, NJ Center on a Tuesday and Thursday or a Monday and Wednesday schedule from 4:30 to 5:30 or 5:30 to 6:30.

Children attend the Scotch Plains, NJ Center on a Tuesday and Thursday or a Monday and Wednesday schedule from 4:30 to 5:30 or 5:30 to 6:30.

Children attend the Northfield, NJ Center on a Monday and Thursday schedule from 4:30 to 5:30 or 5:30 to 6:30.

Children attend the Burlington, NJ Center on a Tuesday and Thursday or a Monday and Wednesday schedule from 4:45 to 5:45 or 5:45 to 6:45.

There is no fee for our instruction, but there is a Registration Fee of \$550.00 per year. No payment is due until a child is enrolled at a Center. Payment is collected in two installments- \$275.00 for the fall semester and \$275.00 for the spring semester. Families who cannot afford this fee, may appeal to the Center's Board Chair.

We are a Teacher Training Program and provide one-on-one Orton-Gillingham instruction to children from grades one to twelve. We generally enroll September through May and we do not have a summer program. Attendance is mandatory and our Program must come before sports and social activities. We do not test, evaluate, or diagnose dyslexia. Unfortunately, not every child that applies to our Program is accepted as it is sometimes determined that a child would be better served with an already trained teacher/tutor. If that is the case, we will inform you of that determination.

In order to process an Application we will need your child's most recent, full and complete, Psychological Evaluation and Educational Evaluation. If you do not have copies, your Child Study Team may be able to provide them to you. We will also accept a child's most recent, full and complete, Neuropsychological Evaluation, conducted by a qualified examiner.
